Case example 2: police has lately been called for several incidents in and around club 'Dancing Queen' (drunken drivers, drug dealing, nuisance, ...). Last week, they received a complaint from a young girl, giving false evidence to the police by saying that she was sexual harassed by several boys after the club hours. Due to some fine police research, they found out that the girl wasn't sexual harassed but spent many hours in the club, drinking, using illegal substances and having unsafe volunteered sex with some boys afterwards. She was afraid to confront her parents at the early morning and made up this version of sexual harassment. This incident was the last straw for the police: they had to do something about the clubbing environment.
